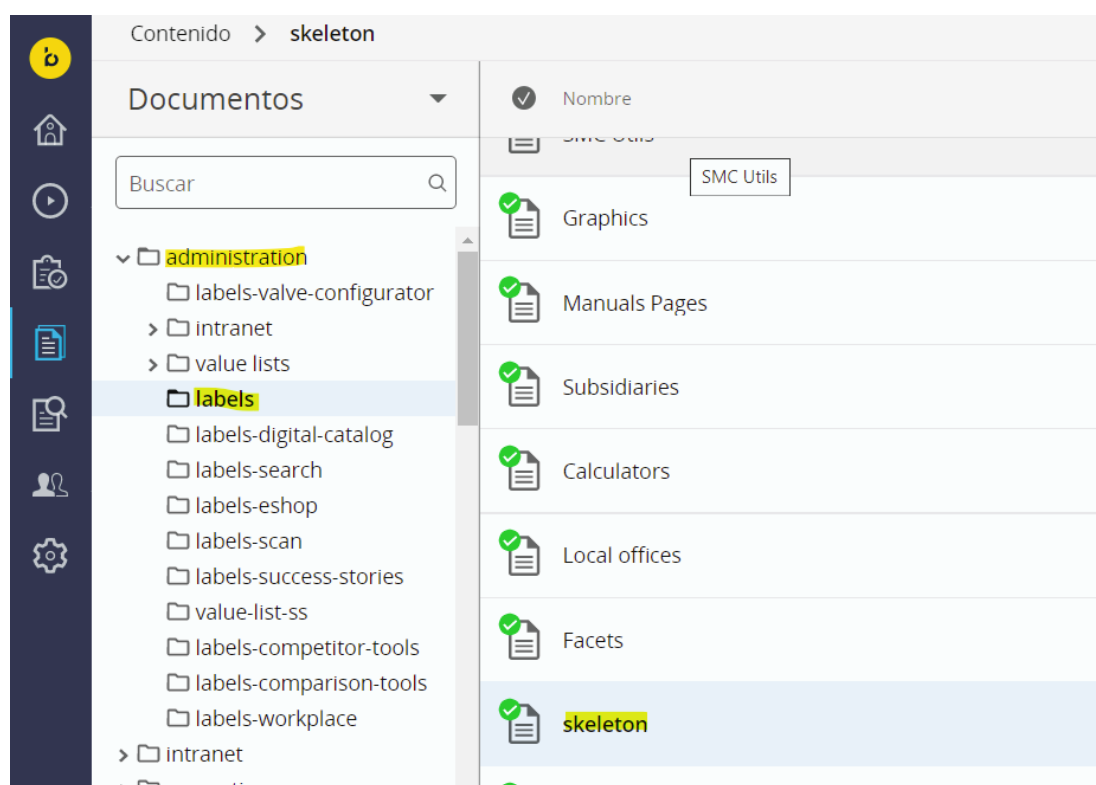

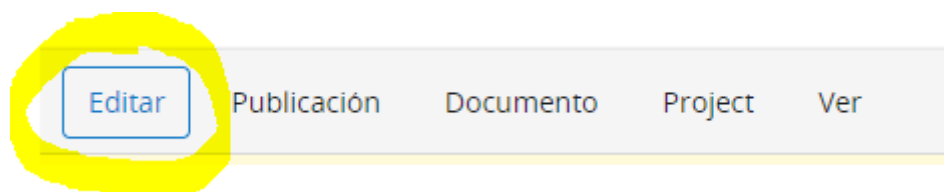


In order to edit the labels under the icon, we have to access from Bloomreach Experience Manager.



The label for country is editable from the bloomreach console.


You have to select the country you want to edit and modify the content of the property `hst:locale`, but not the totality of the label, just the text after the symbol (_).

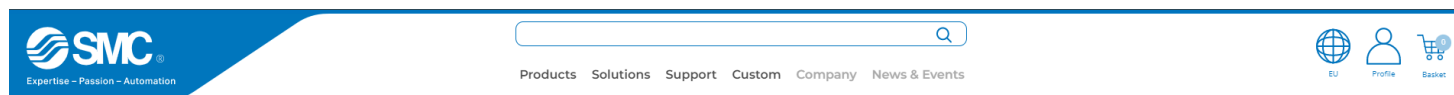


2 LEVEL 1 TOP-MENU

The items of this level are positioned in the central column of the dropdown. They are also differentiated by each type of menu.

First level items refer to browser items. These may have the attribute description products-menu, solutions-menu, support-menu or custom-menu that acquire the desired structure. All those items that do not meet these conditions will be taken as custom. The isHighlighted attribute to false will make the item's color grey, and true will make the item's color black.




3 LEVEL 2 TOP-MENU

These items in their "description" attribute will have the name of the image that you want to associate and that will be located in the `smc_global/global-products/` folder located inside `smc_global`.





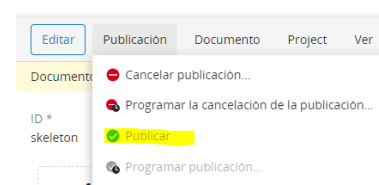
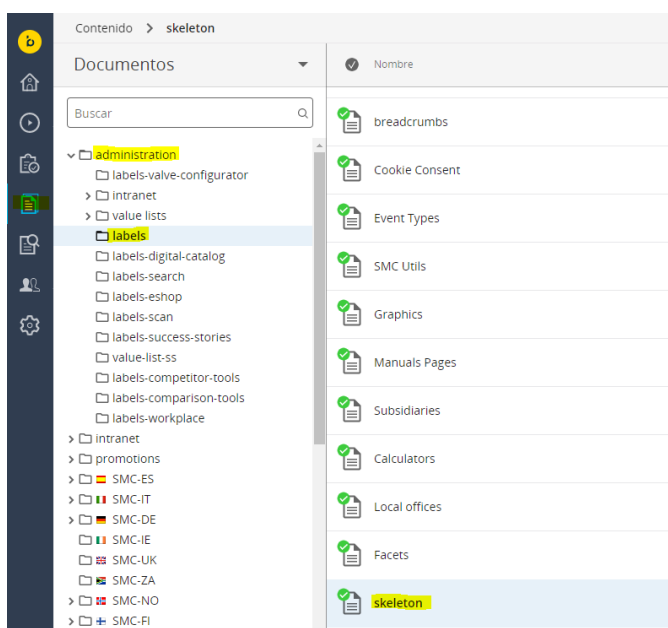
4.5 SUBSCRIBE BUTTON AND NEWSLETTER TEXT

The texts that will appear in these two elements will be defined in the document called "skeleton". The text that will appear on the button will be the one defined in the "skeleton" document with the name footer.subscribe.button.
